Adverse Weather policy

As the winter season starts, many forecasters are predicting this year to be particularly cold with heavy snowfalls. This happens frequently at this time of year, and may well not happen, but we thought it prudent to set out our severe weather policy now:

- At all times, and especially during times of adverse weather conditions, the safety of our passengers and drivers is of the utmost concern, any decisions to cancel, curtail or divert services will be made purely with safety as our primary concern
- We will always endeavour to keep services running whilst ever we feel it is safe to do so, however with many of our routes using rural roads diversions and/or curtailments may happen, sometimes at short notice as conditions change
- The best source of information to see the latest service updates is our Facebook and Twitter feeds, if you are in doubt, you can always call our office (01636-821138), at evenings and weekends the answerphone will give you an alternative number to call which is available 24/7
- In the case of serious adverse weather/road conditions we will always attempt to give enough notice of cancellations, curtailments and diversions to enable you to get to your destination before services are stopped.
- Whilst we will always aim to run school services while the schools remain open, if weather conditions deteriorate during the day, we may run the services early to ensure that we can get all students home safely. Equally, if there are issues of safety in the morning, we may cancel the services to ensure that all students are safe at home, rather than stranded at school.
